Purpose:

The purpose of the policy is to provide direction for the request of the use of burning barrels and fire pits in the Village of Rosalind.

The following protocol has been adopted by the Village of Rosalind:

-
- No burning barrels are allowed on residential property.
 - Fire pits are allowed on residential property.
 - Incinerators are allowed in commercial property. They may be allowed in residential property but need to be approved by council first.
 - You cannot burn household garbage and likes thereof in fire pits.
 - Please use clean wood (not wood that “smells”; it’s a small village)
 - Burning barrels and fire pits do not require a permit.
 - Common sense prevails in placement of burning barrels and fire pits. Council has the right to have them removed if they are deemed not safe and/or are used improperly.
