You may have noticed the new signs on the highway 13 and highway 56, pointing the direction to our local conservation park found on township road 452 closest to range road 185. 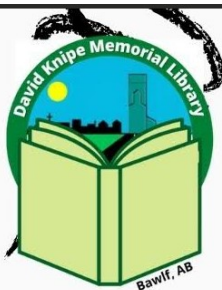
